




GLYNDON LIBRARY— BOOK SUGGESTIONS FOR AUGUST

FROM PASTOR RYAN...

Dear saints at Maranatha:

Grace, mercy, and peace to you from God our Father and from our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Amen.

By now, word has probably reached you that on Sunday, July 14, I announced my resignation as your Associate Pastor at Maranatha. At the same time, I have accepted a call to serve as the senior Pastor at Good Shepherd Free Lutheran Church in Cokato, MN. After much prayer, discernment, and seeking the Lord's guidance, Liz and I believe this is the path He is leading us to follow. My last Sunday at Maranatha will be September 1.

Leaving you all has not been an easy decision. The mixed emotions that accompanied us at the beginning of this process have not gone away in the last few weeks, but the deep sense of peace has continued to accompany us. Maranatha has become family to me, Liz, and the kids, and you have always treated us with love, care, and concern. This has especially been the case in these last weeks as you have showered me with your kind words, phone calls, and texts.

I was not seeking out a new call. I was not discontent here. There have been no hard feelings between myself or the staff or leadership at Maranatha or any of the congregation members (none that I'm aware of anyway!). I have never felt disrespected or looked down on as "just the youth guy."

However, in the space of a few months (beginning in October) I received ten letters of inquiry. I know that I can be slow on the up-take sometimes, but even I started to wonder if the Lord was nudging me to move into a different role. We also pray on a weekly basis for all the congregations without pastors in our AFLC and we feel the Lord's leading to go and fill one of those pastoral voids. I've wrestled over the past few months over whether my work at Maranatha is finished or not. I know there are projects and ministries that are still just beginning (namely Trail Life and the third confirmation year), and I pray that God will raise up the right leaders to continue those ministries as I step away from them.

As Liz and I prepare for this transition, we ask for your prayers—both for us as we do all the things involved in packing, selling a house, finding a new place to live, and moving -- and also for yourselves as a congregation as you seek a new person to fill my role. May God grant us all strength, wisdom, and unity as we navigate these changes.

You are a wonderful congregation to be a part of and we have been blessed these past six years as we've gotten to know you all. Thank you for the cards, notes, gifts, encouraging words, and delicious food you've shared with us. Thank you for allowing me to serve as one of your pastors. It has been an honor and a privilege.
