## From Pastor Lloyd...

Now in those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the Wilderness of Judea, saying, "Repent for the kingdom of Heaven is at hand" (Matthew 3:1-2)

Dear friends at Maranatha,

I have been thinking about repentance lately, probably for at least three reasons:

- 1. Because "repentance" has been coming up a lot in my reading, both in Scripture and in other sources. 2. Because "Repentance" was one of the options Pastor Ryan and I began to consider as a Lenten Theme this year.
- 3. Because I have become freshly aware of the need for "repentance" in certain areas of my own life.

So, just what is repentance? First of all let me explain what it is not. Repentance is <u>not</u> merely inner pain or sorrow or regret due to some past deed. It is <u>not</u> merely doing some outward actions to attempt to remedy a situation that we messed up. Those may go along with repentance, but are not the essence of it. There is no one word in the English language that adequately defines repentance. It comes from the Greek word **metanoia**, which literally means "a change of mind." Even that only begins to explain it. I appreciate the following explanation from Joseph Stump:

Repentance is that act of the Holy Spirit by which through the Law and the Gospel, <u>He works a change of mind in the sinner</u>, so that he comes to contrition of his sins and to faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior. <u>This change of mind affects the **intellect**, the **emotions** and the **will**. (Joseph Stump, The Christian Faith, © 1932, New York, The Macmillan Company)</u>

According to Scripture, repentance is a basic condition for entrance into the Kingdom of God. And so, in that respect we may talk of repentance as becoming aware of one's sinfulness, feeling sorrow for such, and turning from sin to God, and faith in Jesus as Savior. For some persons they look at a certain point in their life in which they experienced this profound change, and it affected their thinking, their emotions and their will. However, repentance is more than a once in a lifetime requirement. The rest of the Christian's life is to be characterized by repentance. God's intention for the believer is that - as he learns more and more from God's Word, he will see spiritual truth with increasing clarity, feel it more and more profoundly, and will to follow it with increasing strength and determination. That is that he would live in daily repentance and faith.

As we at Maranatha in Glyndon observe the season of Lent this year, we will be meeting under the theme: **Who needs repentance?** And we will discover a whole lot of people in both the Old and the New Testament that needed repentance. That some of them needed such - seemed quite obvious; while others hid it well outwardly, but still desperately needed that inner change of heart and mind. Some of the examples we will see include: a godly king, a prophet and the heathens he preached to, a wayward son and his self-righteous brother, a religious leader and a blatant sinner, a crowd of 3,000, and a couple of Jesus' disciples.

Please join us if you can this year during Lent on Sunday mornings and Wednesday nights, as we look together in God's Word relating to this theme. Besides Pastor Ryan and I, several laymen from our congregation will be leading and sharing messages from God's Word at our half hour Lenten Services.

Come early and enjoy suppers served by the youth of our congregation.
